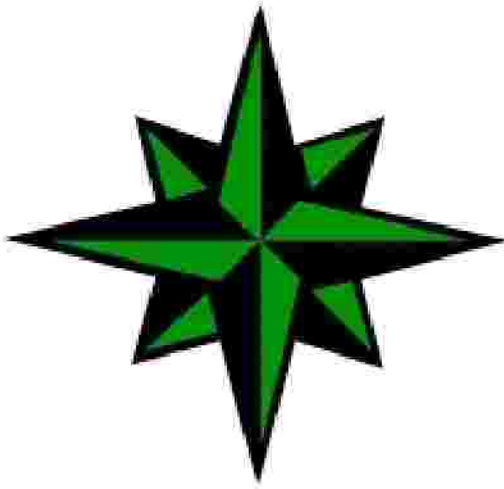

If selected as a participant in Leadership Crawford County, I am willing to attend all the functions sponsored by the program.

Attendance is required to become a graduate of Leadership Crawford County. This involves a two-day mandatory retreat, eight all-day monthly programs, completion of a community project, and commencement exercises. The class day/trip to Springfield on Government day will be mandatory and participants will also be required to go on a 'ride-along' with a county or city patrolman. To be considered for selection, I agree to commit myself to this amount of time. My signature below attests to this commitment. I will notify Leadership Crawford County in extreme situations for excused absences. If I miss **more than two** Class Meetings for any reason, I will not be eligible for graduation. In extenuating circumstances and upon review by the Leadership Crawford County Board of Directors, I may be allowed to make up missed class days during future classes, at my expense, and be eligible to graduate at that time.

The tuition is \$495. I have enclosed payment of \$100 with the application and into Leadership Crawford County, I, my employer, or my sponsor. If no payment is made, the application, will be billed for the remaining balance of the tuition fee (\$395). The application fee will be refunded **only** if the applicant is not accepted by Leadership Crawford County.
