Attendance at functions is crucial to the participant's success in Leadership Crawford County. If your applicant is unable to commit to this schedule, it may not be in his/her best interest to apply at this time.

The Orientation Retreat in September, Government Day in Springfield and Graduation Ceremony are <u>requirements</u> for successful completion of Leadership Crawford County. Participants who miss more than two class meetings <u>for any reason</u> will not be eligible for graduation. In extenuating circumstances and upon review by the Leadership Crawford County Board of Directors, participants may be allowed to make up missed class days during future classes, at the expense of the participant, and be eligible to graduate at that time. Class members will also be required to complete a group project and 10 hours of volunteer time within the community (volunteer time may be waived, dependant upon scope of group project).

Once accepted into the program, no portion of the tuition is refundable.
